1 Logo and MSN Title

Tells you whether you have met the deductible amount for certain services and when the benefit period started

4 Claims Overview

Gives an overview of your approved and denied claims, and the total amount you may be billed

5 Facilities With Claims

Lists the facilities where you accessed services and the dates you went

Definition of Columns 7

Benefit Days Used: The number of covered benefit days you used during each hospital and/or skilled nursing facility stay

Claims Approved?: Tells you if Medicare covered the inpatient stay.

Notes for Claims Above 9

A: Days are being subtracted from your total inpatient hospital benefits for this benefit period.

6 Type of Claim

Can be for inpatient services (accessed once you've been admitted to a hospital) or outpatient services (accessed if you're not admitted to the hospital as an inpatient)

7 Glossary

Explains the meaning of each column in the detailed claims chart

8 Visit Dates

Shows the date(s) you went to the hospital or facility

9 Notes

Points to the bottom of the page for additional information on the supplies and services you received
